

The following Race Management policy was submitted by the DF95 Fleet Captain, approved by the Board, and adopted by all fleet captains for the 2023 season:

The Issue - If a course is set up incorrectly, this can lead to problems on the start line and elsewhere. These issues can lead to protests and bickering.

Each Fleet Captain (or his designate) will work with the RD to set the course and ensure racing is started on time. This will provide good training for RD's as well as afford the best course under the circumstances. The Fleet Captain (or his designate) will have the final say on the course and any issues regarding race management.

There is no need for skippers to shout suggested course modifications to the RD or participate in race management. This only causes confusion and places unnecessary pressure on the RD. The job of the skipper is to enjoy the day and score some good results. If a skipper has any concerns during a race, they should be addressed with the Fleet Captain between races.
